1 Get Started

Keep your kit box

2 Let the Fun Begin

Writing and illustrating

- Carry out a brainstorming session and create a draft before letting your students write on the kit pages.
- Please follow the instructions on the back of the kit pages.
- It's normal for silly sentences and misspellings to find their way into the books.



Design the finishing touches

Your publishing project includes a cover page, title, dedication and authors' page (just like books found in your library).

- **Cover page**
Fill the box with the book title and a colourful illustration.
- **Title and dedication pages**
Fill the pages with colour.
- **Authors' page**
Feel free to glue in a photo of the authors. This page will always be the last page in your book.



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3 Key Steps

Inform the parents

- Issue the **Parent Order Forms**, included in your kit, to each child in your class.
- We recommend you seek parental consent before submitting your books for publishing. We have instructed parents who do not wish for their child's work to be included in the book to bring this to your attention.
- You will receive a **complimentary** hardcover copy of your special book.



4 Post and Publish

Complete your project

- Finalise your order at www.ourclassbook.com/finalise/**
Detailed instructions can be found on the Publishing Checklist included in your kit. Payment must be made before submitting your manuscript for publishing.
- Organise your cover page, title and dedication pages, along with your book pages in numbered order, then your authors' page.
- Fill out the **white box marked with a star** on your kit envelope. ★
- Ensure all the steps on the Publishing Checklist are completed prior to submitting your class' masterpiece for publishing.



Delivery

Adhere the **pre-paid returns label** included in your kit, completely covering the old label. Securely tape your box closed on all sides.

Bring your box to your **local post office** one week before your submission date.

Your published books will be delivered to your school in **just four to five weeks** after we receive your publishing kit. Keep this in mind when planning your celebrations or last day of term.

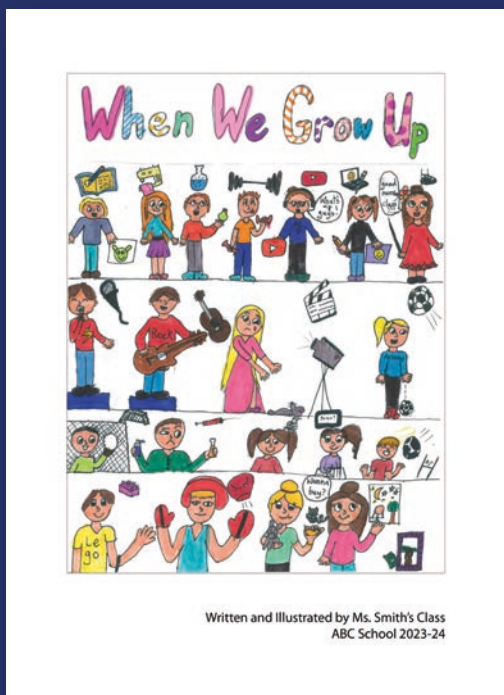
